



General Guidelines for Exhibiting work

- 1. General**

To exhibit your work on the wall at Droitwich Library please email Rhys Jones at rhys@photomaestro.co.uk, giving the dimensions of your picture (including any frame), the orientation (landscape, portrait or square) and prices (if for sale)..

About 9-12 pictures may be displayed at the discretion of the DAN committee.

The fee is £3 per picture per month is payable before your exhibition.

The whole exhibition is changed monthly during the evening Drink and Doodle sessions.

At the end of exhibition please collect your work on the date advised.

Members need to arrange for someone to pick up their exhibits if they are unable to collect as there is no storage space at the library.
- 2. Picture hanging preparation**

String must be attached firmly to the back of the frame. Each frame will hang on two hooks.

Please put your own label on the back of each picture showing your name, title, and the price of the item.

A card showing Artist and Contact Details, Title and Price should be placed in the bottom left-hand corner of the frame.
- 3. Constraints**

Participation will be limited to DAN (paid up) members only.

We are expected to exhibit high quality works of art. The organisers reserve the right to select which works will be displayed. Art work must be tasteful and fit in with a public environment where children are often present.

Pictures are exhibited at the owner's risk. If your picture is very valuable, consider arranging your own insurance.

DAN is not responsible for exhibits once the exhibition has ended.
- 4. Change over**

The whole exhibition changes each month and members will be advised of changeover dates.
- 5. Sales**

The library can handle sales charging commission of 25%+VAT. You can place a business card in the corner of the pictures. Contact details for each artist and prices for their pictures is usually shown on the notice board.
